ISCC is sponsoring the Leadership Arlington Youth Program

As approved at the last meeting, ISCC is contributing \$1,000.00 towards the Philanthropy portion of the Leadership Arlington Youth Program.

From the LA web-site:

The Youth Program training is hands-on, experiential learning. Daily sessions focus on professionalism, culture competency and commitment, mentoring, facilitation, and philanthropy. One highlight is our "Philanthropy into Action" program session. This session offers participants the experience to learn the value of philanthropy through site visits to local non-profits in Arlington. Participants are given the task to decide on one non-profit to be the recipient of a \$1,000 grant. Students develop their own criteria for evaluating each non-profit, visit approximately 20 nonprofits during the program weeks, and come to a consensus on who is the recipient of the grant.

This is a great stepping stone to developing a lasting relationship with Leadership Arlington's Youth Program as well as their Leadership Training for Arlington's business professionals.
